MODERN SLAVERY DATA SHARING PROGRAM

In 2015 we announced the development of a global information and intelligence platform to combat slavery, helping corporations to eradicate it from supply chains by gathering data from NGOs and others working on the frontlines on a daily basis.



SUPPLIER SCREENING Thomson Reuters World-Check consists of millions of profiles on individuals, entities and vessels to reveal the risk hiding in business relationships and networks. Dataset contains over 48,000 profiles concerning human trafficking and related human rights abuses.

THOMSON REUTERS ENHANCED DUE DILIGENCE Relevant reports cover specific risks relating to forced, bonded and child labor.

WORKING WITH CIVIL SOCIETY Partnered with leading NGOs Verite and Liberty Asia in the belief that powerful data analytics will enable companies to identify sources of labor in their supply chains and avoid risk of involvement in exploitation.

Thomson Reuters Special Services (TRSS)

TRSS alongside partners in nonprofits, other corporations, think tanks, and law enforcement, provides innovative solutions at each stage of the trafficking process to combat the threat.

TRSS has assisted law enforcement with an investigation leading to the recovery of nine victims, including three under the age of 18, during Super Bowl XLVIII. TRSS thought leadership provides guidance on emerging technologies in trafficking and the role of big data and how the dark web changes the rules of the game.


